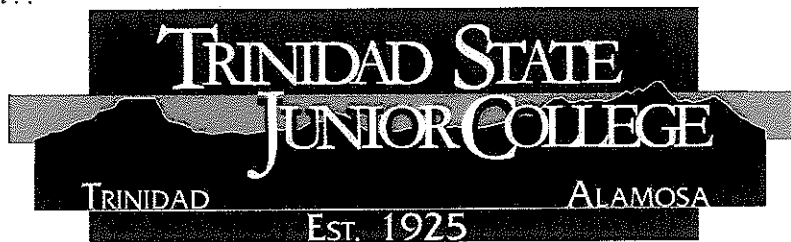

Formatting:

- 1" top, bottom, left, and right margin
- Times New Roman font in 12 point size
- At the top (right justified and single spaced) type your name on the first line, school name on the second line, "Autobiography for Red Carpet Event" on the third line, and the day you are attending the event on the fourth line
- The body of the paper should be left justified, and double spaced with three paragraphs indented.

1st Paragraph:

- Introduce who you are
- Identify activities that you are involved in at your school or outside of school hours (specifically anything related to a program of study you are interested in)
- Provide details about academics if you have high scores in school
- Provide details about athletics or clubs that you have participated in, church organizations, or other activities that are important to you

2nd Paragraph:

- Explain the program(s) you are interested in and how you will use the \$500 scholarship
- Also tell us what type of work you want to do after college, and its always a good idea to mention if you want to live in the town where you will go to school after graduation

3rd Paragraph:

- In conclusion, tell us what you need to know to make the entry into college easier (scholarship, tutoring, test preparation, job placement, college budgeting, etc.)

After you have proof-read and spell checked your document, print and give the document to your counselor. They will turn in all of the autobiographies to your school counselor.

help athletes recover from injuries. My family lives in Hooper, so I hope to work either in the

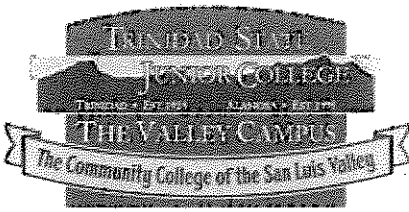
one of the local elementary schools or at the medical center in Alamosa.

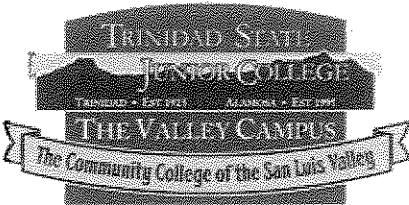
